C. Fricke made a motion to R. Nelson to serve as proxy. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.

AGENDA ADDITIONS – None

PUBLIC COMMENTS – None

MINUTES – No additions or corrections were made to the January minutes draft.

M. Reynolds made a motion to accept the minutes from the January 5, 2026 meeting. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.

CORRESPONDENCE – There was no new correspondence to report on.

SECRETARY/TREASURER REPORT –

a. The Chapter 94 Report needs to be completed and signed. A motion is needed to allow Milnes to complete the report and to allow S. Cantner to sign the report and submit.

B. Edwards made a motion to hire Milnes to complete the Chapter 94 report and allow S. Cantner to sign and submit the report once done. Martin seconded the motion. All yea.

b. We received notification that we will be paving work done throughout the Borough. Originally, PennDOT thought the paving would affect some of the sewer lines. PennDOT reviewed and determined that this would not be the case.

C. Fricke made a motion to approve the Secretary/Treasurer Report. B. Edwards seconded the motion. All yea.

BILLS – All bills to be paid are listed. Unusual expenses included \$8,186.72 to Hester for the regular contract amount along with the UV light replacement work that was voted on last month and \$84.00 for the PS Bank fee for our loan which is payable every five years.

B. Edwards made a motion to pay the bills. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.

OPERATOR'S REPORT – Operator M. Hester reported that the sewer plant is in good working order producing effluent within the permitted limits. The UV disinfection system work was completed including installation of the new bulbs and ballasts. M. Hester completed the quarterly blower, rake unit, influent skimmer, and DO probe maintenance. The annual treatment plant generator service is due. M. Hester is seeking permission to do the service work at the same rate as last year: \$1035.

B. Edwards made a motion to allow M. Hester to complete the generator service work for \$1035.00. C. Fricke seconded the motion. All yea.

C. Fricke made a motion to accept the Operator's report. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS – None

C. Fricke made a motion to adjourn the Sewer Authority Meeting. B. Edwards seconded the motion. All yea.
