PUBLIC COMMENTS – None

MINUTES – No additions or corrections were made to the May 18, 2026 minutes.

C. Fricke made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 18th, 2026 meeting. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.

CORRESPONDENCE – There was no new correspondence to report on.

SECRETARY/TREASURER REPORT –

S. Cantner reviewed her secretary report. The new phone line will be put in next Wednesday. Alarms are going off at Keystone, so Vector was contacted. Late notices were sent out, Portnoff will receive new notices, and third quarter billing will be sent at the end of the month.

B. Edwards made a motion to approve the Secretary report. C. Fricke seconded the motion. All yea.

BILLS – All bills to be paid are listed. Unusual expenses included \$6,547.76 to PS Bank for a loan payment increase due to interest rate change, \$4,500 to Higgins Construction for sewer manhole work that was already approved at last meeting, \$5,768.76 to Hester Wastewater for contract plus work previously approved, and \$289.90 to Vector Security for the monthly contract fee and a service call.

C. Fricke made a motion to pay the bills. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.

OPERATOR'S REPORT – M. Hester reviewed the operator's report. The Sewer Plant is in good working order producing effluent within permitted limits. There was one alarm call on May 18th at 7:40pm for influent wet well issues. The new floats and weights were installed in the influent well. At the same time, M. Hester also fished out airline retention cable out of the aeration tank and reattached it. Daily maintenance noted that a UV ballast had burned out so that was also replaced. M. Hester diagnosed a low fuel pressure issue with the plant's

generator, which is a failed check valve in the actual fuel pump on the engine. The inline check valve is likely causing the problem and needs to be removed. A replacement fuel pump from John Deere is \$156.65. Hose and clamps will also be needed. Finally, the rake unit drive motor is making noise in the clarifier. Oil for the unit is \$283.02 for 5 gallons. This may not fix the issue but is well worth trying as a replacement is difficult to find.

B. Edwards made a motion to approve Mike Hester to purchase the replacement fuel pump for \$156.65 and any necessary hoses and clamps and oil for the motor in the amount of \$283.02. M. Renyolds seconded the motion. All yea.

C. Fricke made a motion to accept the Operator's report. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.

OLD/NEW BUSINESS – Nothing

B. Edwards made a motion to adjourn the Sewer Authority Meeting. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.

The meeting of the Factoryville Borough and Clinton Township Joint Municipal Sewer Authority was adjourned at 6:09pm. The next meeting will take place on July 8th, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at the Factoryville Borough Hall.
