

The Factoryville Borough and Clinton Township Joint Municipal Sewer Authority held its meeting on May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026. This meeting was rescheduled from May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 due to lack of quorum. The meeting was called to order by Authority Chairperson Dan Engler at 10am.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS** – None

**MINUTES** – No additions or corrections were made to the April 8th, 2026 minutes.

*L. Jasikoff made a motion to accept the minutes from the April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026 meeting. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.*

**CORRESPONDENCE** – There was no new correspondence to report on.

**SECRETARY/TREASURER REPORT** –

S. Cantner reviewed her secretary report. She stated that an extra phone line is needed at the sewer plant for the continued issues with the alarm system. This will be less than \$100 per month but no actual rate has been made.

*B. Edwards made a motion to approve the second phone line at the plant. L. Jaskioff seconded the motion. All yea.*

She informed the board that we received \$26,822.60 in sewer income and will be sending past due balances out next week.

*B. Edwards made a motion to approve the Secretary report. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.*

**BILLS** – All bills to be paid are listed. Unusual expenses included \$3,080.00 Scranton Craftsman for the sewer rings, \$4,500.00 for Higgins Construction, and \$1,574.72 for New Enterprise, all for the sewer rings throughout town. \$570.00 was for Milnes and the Chapter 94 report they did.

*C. Fricke made a motion to pay the bills. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.*

**OPERATOR'S REPORT** – S. Cantner reviewed the operator report. She noted that the sewer plant is in good working order producing effluent within the permitted limits. The replacement DO controller unit was received and he will be installing that this month. He spoke with the myriad help line and will also get that installed this month. He did the influent pump control panel sealed up. The next step that we should do is to replace the four back-up control floats that are in the influent wet well. The current floats are spliced in the wet well which allows sewer gas to get into the cables and corrode them. Floats with weights are \$195 each plus install time of 3-4 with two men.

***B. Edwards made a motion to approve Mike Hester to purchase the four back-up control floats and weights. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.***

***M. Reynolds made a motion to accept the Operator's report. B. Edwards seconded the motion. All yea.***

**OLD/NEW BUSINESS** –

Old Business – Jim Gesek states that we will need to increase the dumpster dumping to two times a month. This will increase the rate from \$51 to \$73 plus taxes per month.

***B. Edwards made a motion to approve the contract of twice a month for Waste Management dumpster agreement for a term of three years at \$73 a month. C. Fricke seconded the motion. All yea.***

Jim has continued to work on the sewer ring replacements throughout town. He has seven more to do and requests approval to hire Higgins Construction for 3 more days at a rate of \$1,500 per day.

***B. Edwards made a motion to hire Higgins Construction for three additional days at a total of \$4,500. L. Jasikoff seconded the motion. All yea.***

***L. Jasikoff made a motion to adjourn the Sewer Authority Meeting. M. Reynolds seconded the motion. All yea.***

The meeting of the Factoryville Borough and Clinton Township Joint Municipal Sewer Authority was adjourned at 10:08am. The next meeting will take place on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at the Factoryville Borough Hall.
